DELIVERING MUCH NEEDED UPGRADES TO QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK

Federal Member for Reid Sally Sitou has today announced that a re-elected Albanese Labor Government will deliver a \$1.5 million upgrade to the Queen Elizabeth Park amenities block.

This \$1.5 million election commitment will fund the construction of a new amenities building to replace the existing one, which is no longer fit-for-purpose.

The new building will be located adjacent to three sportsgrounds and will include changerooms, bathrooms, public toilets and a canteen.

This upgrade will significantly enhance the facilities for all park users, including local schools and community members.

It will also support the Russell Lea Women's Soccer Club, which has approximately 300 registered players, and the Inner West Harbour Cricket Association, representing clubs with hundreds of players across the inner west and lower north shore.

This election commitment builds on the government's previous investments in local sports infrastructure, demonstrating our ongoing dedication to improving community facilities and supporting grassroots sports.

Consistent with past practice, election commitments will be delivered in line with Commonwealth Grants Rules and Principles.
